NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA)
2023-2024 GRANT YEAR:

RURAL COMMUNITY ASSETS FUND (RCAF)

Strengthens the power and capacity of community organizations to further their missions by recruiting, equipping and mobilizing volunteers who serve Floridians in rural communities.



GRANT OVERVIEW

- 1) Distribution of a collective total of \$100,000, contingent upon availability of funds
 - 2) Provides organizational and training support for grantees participating in 2023-2024 grant years
 - 3) Requests may be between \$5,000 and \$10,000
- 4) Must provide a one hundred percent (100%) cash or inkind match (or combination), to be verified during the contract period.



GRANT OVERVIEW

- 5) 50% of approved grant request distributed at the beginning of the grant cycle, 50% at mid-cycle.
 - 6) Supporting documentation required.
- 7) Grantees will receive- and are expected to participate in- Volunteer Florida Foundation provided or approved comprehensive training, ongoing technical assistance, and coaching



ELIGIBILITY

- 1) The applicant must be a public or private 501c(3) nonprofit organization, including:
 - faith-based and other community organizations;
 - institutions of higher education;
 - government entities (e.g., states, cities, counties, school systems, etc.); or
 - Indian Tribes.

Project fiscal agent: Must be an established IRS 501(c)3 tax-exempt organization that agrees to accept donations on behalf of a group that does not have IRS exemption.



ELIGIBILITY

- 2) Must be a Florida-based organization
- 3) Must establish or have a service location in, or volunteers deployed to an eligible rural area.
- 4) RCAF funds may only be used to support individuals residing in eligible rural areas.



ELIGIBILITY

- 5) Proposed budget line items relevant to volunteer engagement work completed <u>outside of the eligible rural area</u> may be included if they:
 - Directly contribute to the achievement of grant performance measures in the eligible rural area chosen by the grantee.
- 6) Geographic locations eligible for RCAF funding must be part of one of the designated "Rural Areas of Opportunity (RAO)" as authorized by the Governor and outlined in F.S. 288.0656



FATAL CRITERIA

- 1) Application Submission: Blackbaud Grantmaking online portal Wednesday, September 20, 2023, by 5:00pm EDT
- 2) The applicant is a Florida based organization and operates in an eligible rural community as defined.
- 3) Public or private 501c(3) nonprofit organization defined in Eligibility section



FATAL CRITERIA

- 4) IRS tax exemption status as a 501(c)3 nonprofit is currently in good standing.
- 5) Mobilizes or will mobilize volunteers to meet the mission of the organization
- 6) Includes the selection of relevant performance measures
- 7) Allowable grant amount of between \$5,000 \$10,000
- 8) 100% match of the requested grant amount established


